25 gibberish and proved to be extremely excitable and difficult
26 to control. After admittance to the hospital he seemed to
27 possess a veritable stockpile of different disguises which he
28 donned mysteriously and at a moment's notice always in an at-
29 tempt to mock the person he was with. Extremely antisocial,
30 bad manners, low self opinion.

31 4. That he verily believes it to be for the best interest of the said alleged person that he be admitted to an insti-
32 tution for mental disease.
