Sector indexes	Description
SXBSC Index	The STOXX Basic Materials Sector index for Europe. Using the market standard ICB Industry Classification Benchmark, companies are categorised according to their primary source of revenue. This categorisation guarantees a professional and accurate classification of companies in their respective business environments.
SX8E Index	The STOXX Technology Sector index for Europe. It is a capital-weighted index which includes countries that are participating in the EMU that are involved in the technology sector. The index was developed with the base value of 100 as of December 31, 1991. Using the market standard ICB Industry Classification Benchmark, companies are categorised according to their primary source of revenue.
SXFE Index	The STOXX Financial Sector index for Europe. It is a capital-weighted index which includes countries that are participating in the EMU that are involved in the financial service sector. The index was developed with the base value of 100 as of December 31, 1991. Using the market standard ICB Industry Classification Benchmark, companies are categorised according to their primary source of revenue.
SXIDUE Index	The STOXX Industrial Sector index for Europe. Using the market standard ICB Industry Classification Benchmark, companies are categorised according to their primary source of revenue. This categorisation guarantees a professional and accurate classification of companies in their respective business environments.
BECNCY Index	Bloomberg European Consumer Non-cyclical Index is a cap-weighted index of the most highly capitalized european companies in ECU traded european exchanges including the consumer non-cyclical sector.
BECCYC Index	Bloomberg European Consumer Cyclical Index is a cap-weighted index of the most highly capitalized european companies in ECU traded european exchanges including the consumer cyclical sector.
S12COMM Index	S&P global 1200 communications equipment index.
BEENRG Index	Bloomberg European Energy Index is a cap-weighted index of the most highly capitalized european companies in ECU traded european exchanges including the energy sector.
MXEU0DF Index	Europe Diversified Financial Index is a free-float weighted equity index. It was developed with a base value of 100 as of December 31, 1998.
BET-FI Index	Bucharest stock exchange trading funds index is a capitalization weighted index compared of the investment funds listed on BSE, the index was developed with a base value of 1000 as of November 1, 2000.
SX6E Index	The STOXX Utilities Sector index for Europe. It is a capital-weighted index which includes countries that are participating in the EMU that are involved in the utility sector. The index was developed with the base value of 100 as of December 31, 1991. Using the market standard ICB Industry Classification Benchmark, companies are categorised according to their primary source of revenue.
