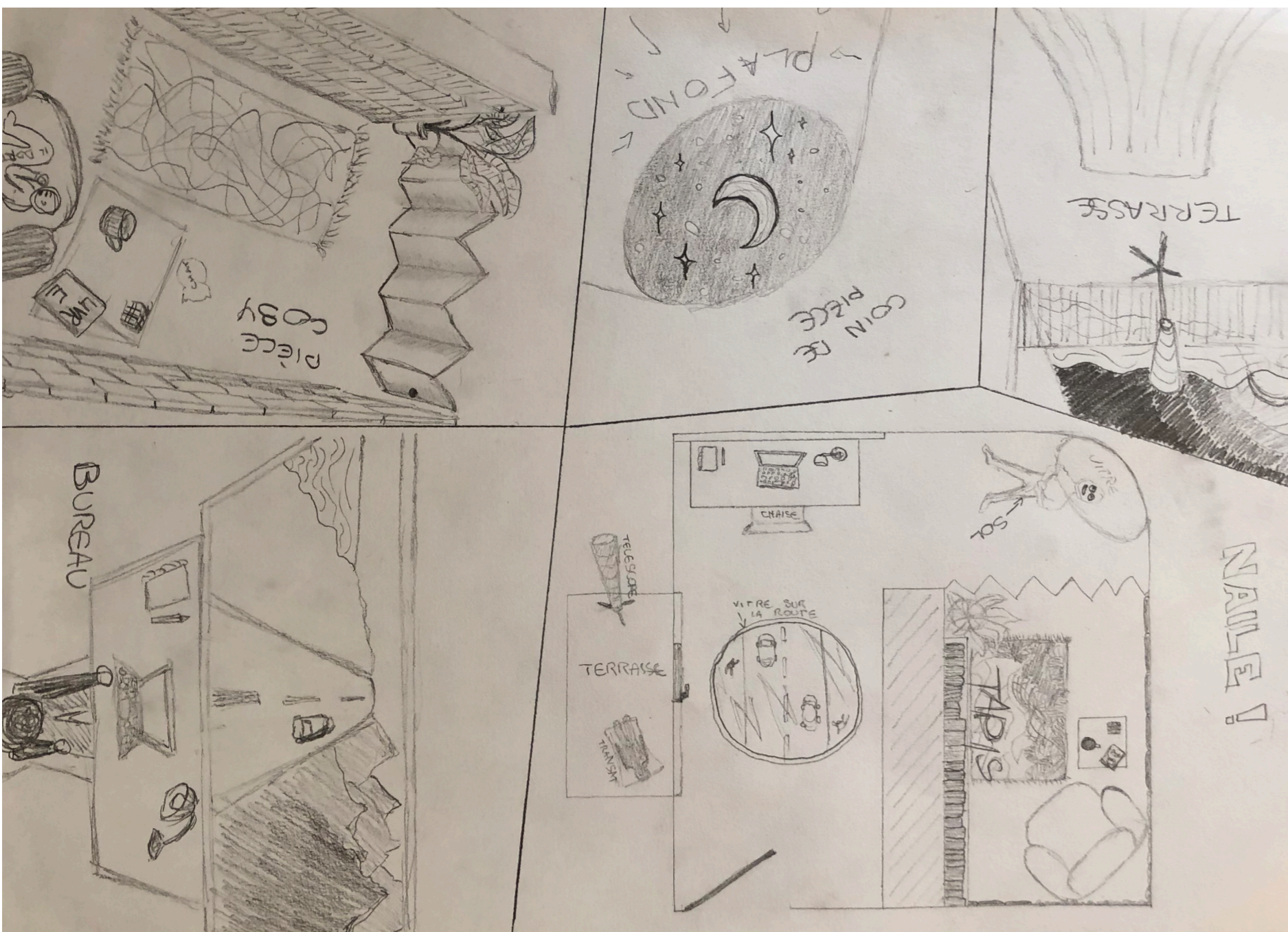


«The ideal place is a house with a veranda where there is a large table to meet, overlooking nature and the first jonquils.»
